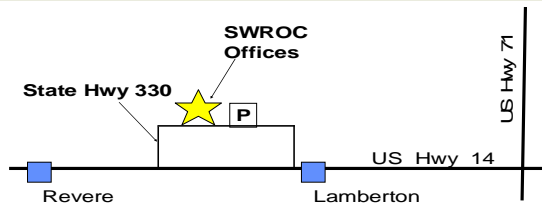

Her MPH in Public Health Nutrition is from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill and her BS in Community Dietetics is from the University of North Dakota, Grand Forks. Dr. Stang is also the principal investigator for the National Maternal Nutrition Intensive Course.

Dr. Stang's research focuses on nutrition and weight status in pregnancy; child and adolescent nutrition; behavioral counseling in child obesity; and eating disorders treatment. She has published in many journals.
